Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1691) to protect religious liberty.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 1691) to  
4 protect religious liberty. The bill shall be considered as  
5 read for amendment. The amendment recommended by  
6 the Committee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill  
7 shall be considered as adopted. The previous question shall  
8 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on

1 any further amendment thereto to final passage without  
2 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the  
3 bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by the  
4 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
5 on the Judiciary; (2) a further amendment printed in the  
6 Congressional Record pursuant to clause 8 of rule XVIII,  
7 if offered by Representative Conyers of Michigan or his  
8 designee, which shall be considered as read and shall be  
9 separately debatable for one hour equally divided and con-  
10 trolled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one  
11 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
